- Gives access to bicycles for anyone to use at anytime

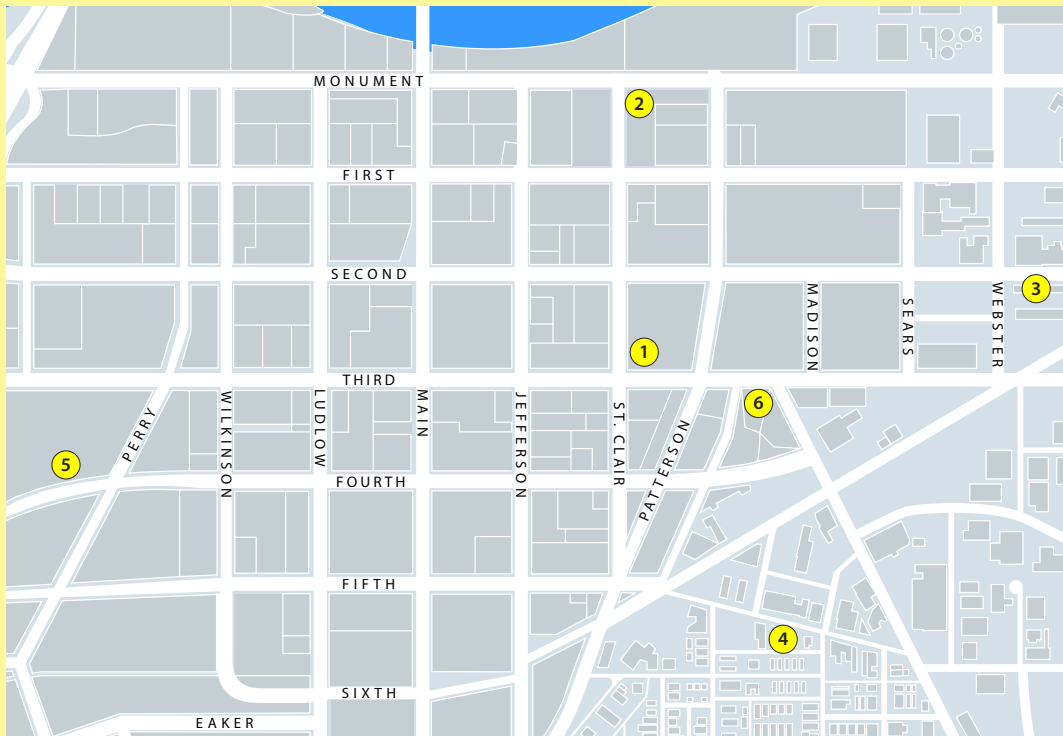
How do I participate in the program?
