



New Us, New You: Dayton to Reveal Remodeled Rec Centers

The City of Dayton will celebrate the remodeling of two recreation centers with open houses, ceremonies and special activities scheduled for Friday, March 12.

The “Reveal” of these renovations will highlight improvements at the Lohrey and Northwest Recreation Centers, including remodeled and expanded fitness rooms, a new auxiliary gymnasium, modern lobbies/entrances and more. The improvements represent an investment of \$3 million in Dayton’s recreation amenities.

At Lohrey (2366 Glenarm Ave.), a ribbon-cutting is scheduled for 3:00 p.m., followed by an open house for patrons and the community until 7:00 p.m. At Northwest (1600 Princeton Ave.), a ribbon-cutting is scheduled for 4:30 p.m., followed by an open house until 8:00 p.m.

At both centers, there will be fitness class demonstrations beginning at 5:00 p.m., as well as refreshments, give-aways and discounts on purchases of new aquatic and/or fitness passes.

Mayor Gary Leitzell and other City officials will offer brief remarks at each ceremony. The recreation center improvements are one part of a master plan to improve recreation and leisure opportunities for Dayton residents.
