



City Softball Complex Goes Green

The Kettering Field Softball Complex has joined with other City of Dayton operations to go green.

During the recent citywide softball tournament, 20 large barrels of recycled materials were collected for inclusion in the City's recycling program.

The Department of Recreation and Youth Services, managers of the Kettering Field Complex (444 North Bend Blvd.), will continue to offer recycling throughout the softball season, which ends October 3.

In June, Dayton residents recycled approximately 500 tons of waste through the City's recycling program. The 500 tons per month level has been a key goal since the City's expanded recycling program was launched two years ago because at that volume the "tipping fee" charged to the City by the recycler is reduced to zero.
