Four Dayton firefighters are the recipients of the Firefighter of the Year award given by the Greater Montgomery County Fire Chiefs Association and will be honored at a banquet to be held Saturday, January 14, 6:00 p.m., at the Moraine Country Club.

Lieutenants Bradley Baldwin and Ray Bush and Firefighters John Cline and Brian Jay will be recognized for their response to a dangerous house fire at 75 Alaska St. on August 16, 2011.

During that event, the four firefighters (with assistance from a citizen, Mr. William Stewart) were at the heart of an effort to rescue a trapped resident during heavy fire and smoke complicated by a roof collapse and inaccessible windows.

The Dayton firefighters were chosen from among nominees representing fire departments throughout Montgomery County.
