Please remember to use the City of Dayton's recycling containers to recycle items at home.



Recyclable items include:



Telephone Books



Magazines, Catalogs & Junk Mail



Cardboard/ Shipping Boxes



All Paper Products/ Newspapers



Plastics (No Lids)



Steel Containers (Food Cans)



Aluminum Cans



Glass Bottles, Jars & Containers

**Remember to Rinse: Bottles, Cans, Jugs, Containers.*

No items containing residual food or liquids, such as paper plates, paper towels, tissues, pizza boxes, etc.

Recycling does more than just protect the environment — it also saves the City money.

- Recycling reduces the volume of trash taken to landfills.
- Less waste to landfills cuts down on high disposal costs; \$38.25 a ton for regular waste versus just \$6.00 a ton for recycled.
- Cutting traditional disposal costs means saving tax dollars to be used for other efforts.

Remember: the more we recycle, the more money our city saves.
